

# 2013 ASCE PACIFIC SOUTH WEST CONFERENCE Scavenger Hunt

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

To encourage teamwork, explorer, and social media skills

### **EVENT DESCRIPTION:**

The Scavenger Hunt will begin on Thursday April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 8am and end on Friday April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 6:30pm. Teams will work together to complete as many tasks as possible on the Scavenger Hunt list in order to earn as many points as possible. New to the Hunt this year, there is also a Twitter portion to the competition where teams will be required to tweet completed tasks @PSWC2013 before finding out what the next clue is.

### PARTICIPANTS:

- Each school may enter one team only.
- Each team must consist of at least 2 members.
- Each team member must be a registered participant of the PSWC 2013.
- Each team must have at least one underclassman.
- Each team must have at least one female.
- Each team must have a designated captain.

## **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. Teams are required to send both the designated team captain and one underclassmen member to pick up and submit the Scavenger Hunt List.
- 2. Teams must pick up the Scavenger Hunt List between 8 am and 8:30 am on Thursday April 4th, 2013, from a location to be announced.
- 3. The Scavenger Hunt List will have various tasks; each task will be assigned a task number. Teams should try to complete as many tasks as possible
- Teams are required to bring at least one digital camera. Teams will use the camera to take photos that clearly show each task was completed.









- 5. Teams may submit only one photo per task. Each photo must be named in the following format "SCHOOL ABBREVIATION TASK NUMBER". For example: "USC 69" will be the file name for the photo University of Southern California submits to show that they completed task 69 on the Scavenger Hunt List. All photos must be in JPEG format.
- 6. Teams must place their correctly labeled photos on a CD, DVD, or USB Flash Drive for submittal.
- Any photos that are not correctly labeled will be deleted and not judged. Non-Scavenger Hunt material should not be included on the CD/DVD/USB. Judges may refuse to check a submittal that is unorganized or confusing.
- 8. It is the team's responsibility to ensure their submittal is in the correct/readable format.
- 9. Teams may begin submitting their CD/DVD/USB at 5 pm on Friday April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at a location to be announced. Any submittals after 6:30 pm will not be accepted.
- 10. All final submittal deadlines/requirements will be printed on the Scavenger Hunt List. Further instructions and rules will also be printed on the Scavenger Hunt List.
- 11. The time each team submits their CD/DVD/USB will be recorded for tie breaker purposes. In the case of a tie, the team that turned in their CD/DVD/USB earlier is ranked higher.
- 12. Each team must bring their own CD, DVD, or USB Flash Drive to place their correctly labeled photos on and submit. The CD/DVD/USB can be returned to its respective school if requested at the time of submittal.
- 13. IN ADDITION to the rules above, there will be a Twitter portion to the Hunt. Teams will be given an initial task when their List is picked up and must tweet the photo of the completed task @PSWC2013. That school will then receive the next task in a private message (A mobile device with a camera and data is very strongly recommended).
- 14. Teams may tweet photos at any time, but during the hours of 9:30 pm and 7:30 am, the next clue will not be provided. Photos tweeted during these hours will be responded to in the order in which they were tweeted when the clues open back up. 6:30 pm on Friday April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013 is the final cutoff.









15. ALL submitted photos will be judged on originality and creativity. Twitter photos will also be judged on creativity of their caption and hashtag(s).
